Australian people care a lot about their health. They think Japanese food is healthy, so it became popular. Now they think Japanese green tea is a healthy drink. Green tea has $\frac{\text{tannins}}{(\grave{\pm})}$. Tannin has a lot of $\frac{\text{catechin}}{(\grave{\pm})}$. Some scientists say that people will not get cancer if they have a lot of catechin. People in Shizuoka do not die of cancer very often. Maybe it is because people there make and drink a lot of green tea.

Green tea is made from the same leaves as $\frac{\text{black tea.}}{(\frac{1}{2})}$. Then is green tea different from black tea? The answer is "Yes." Green tea is dried for a shorter time. So some Australians drink it as an $\frac{\text{herb}}{(\frac{1}{2})}$ tea. They sometimes drink green tea with honey. Isn't that interesting?
