Just like in Japan, all banks have ATMs. In the United States, they are outside (注) the bank and can be used 24 hours a day. When we need money at two o'clock on Sunday morning, we can get it. And we almost never have to wait for a long time. Sometimes people say in joke that such useful ATMs are dangerous-it's very easy to spend money!

Once I told a Japanese friend that you can use ATMs day and night in the U.S. She was surprised and said, "But what do you do if you have a problem with the ATM at night?"

About ten years ago I had a problem with an ATM at about 9 P.M. on a rainy Friday night. I put my bank card in to take out \$200. Then there was a big flash of lightning, and the ATM stopped. When it came on again, the ATM gave my bank card back to me with a piece of paper showing that my money in the bank was \$200 less than before. But the ATM did not give me any money. The next Monday, I went to the bank and told the story of the last Friday night. First, people there couldn't understand such a strange thing. But in the end, everything was all right.
